Applications are invited for the position of Director of the Centre for Refugee Studies for a term of five years, to begin July 1, 2019.

ORU Description and History:

The Centre for Refugee Studies (CRS) was founded at York in 1988; its first director was Howard Adelman. CRS is an interdisciplinary community of researchers dedicated to advancing the well-being of refugees and others displaced by violence, persecution, human rights abuses, and environmental degradation through innovative research, education, and policy engagement. CRS is recognized as an international leader in the creation, mobilization, and dissemination of new knowledge that addresses forced migration issues in local, national and global contexts.

Position Requirements:

Applicants are expected to be members of the full-time faculty at York University, and to have a distinguished record of scholarship and research interests. The Director is expected to administer the financial, organizational and academic and collegial activities of the ORU, to develop external funding sources, and to maintain an active individual and collaborative research program.

Stipend:

The successful applicant will receive an administrative stipend and the appropriate course load reduction as stipulated by the YUFA or OHFA Collective Agreement. The Director of the Centre reports to the Associate Vice-President Research.
