Applications are invited for the position of Director of the Centre for Research on Latin America and the Caribbean for a term of five years, to begin July 1, 2020.

ORU Description and History:

CERLAC is an inter-disciplinary and trans-disciplinary Organized Research Unit supporting the research of York University faculty and graduate students on Latin America and the Caribbean, their diasporas, and their relations with Canada and the rest of the world. It is the oldest research centre of its kind in Canada and one of the oldest ORUs at York, having just celebrated its 40th anniversary, and has a distinguished tradition of promoting social justice, human rights, and international research projects.

Position Requirements:

Applicants are expected to be members of the full-time faculty at York University, and to have a distinguished record of scholarship and research interests. The Director is expected to administer the financial, organizational and academic and collegial activities of the ORU, to develop external funding sources, and to maintain an active individual and collaborative research program.

Stipend:

The successful applicant will receive an administrative stipend and the appropriate course load reduction as stipulated by the YUFA or OHFA Collective Agreement. The Director of the Centre reports to the Associate Vice-President Research.
