Applications and nominations are invited for the position of Director of the Centre for Vision Research for a term of five years, to begin July 1, 2020.

ORU Description and History:

The Centre for Vision Research (CVR) pursues world-class, interdisciplinary research and training in visual science and its applications. Vision is a primary input not only for understanding the world around us, but also for guiding actions that determine our interactions with the world. The CVR provides an effective infrastructure that encourages collaboration among members and across discipline. CVR attracts funding for major research and training programs, e.g., from CFREF, CFI, and CREATE, involving collaborations both across the university and with external partners.

Position Requirements:

Applicants are expected to be members of the full-time faculty at York University, and to have a distinguished record of scholarship, training, external funding, and research leadership in the field of vision science. The Director should also demonstrate experience with organization, administration and external collaborations. The Director is expected to administer the financial, organizational and academic and collegial activities of the ORU, to lead in the development and sustenance of major external funding sources and partnerships, and to maintain an active individual and collaborative research program.

Stipend:

The successful applicant will receive an administrative stipend and the appropriate course load reduction as stipulated by the YUFA Collective Agreement. The Director of the Centre reports to the Associate Vice-President Research.
